What is TRENAL?

TRENAL (TRANSLATIONAL KIDNEY RESEARCH – FROM PHYSIOLOGY TO CLINICAL APPLICATION) is a DAAD-funded Thematic Network in which FAU, Charité, Yale University (YALE) and University College London (UCL) collaborate to develop new research paths in kidney research and translate them into novel diagnostic and therapeutic strategies. The goal of this network is to strengthen the interaction among the partners through an exchange program for medical and doctoral students, postdoctoral researchers and faculty members, providing the opportunity to undertake a period of education, research or clinical exchange at the partnering institutions.

What is being funded?

This part of the program will enable faculty members to visit partnering institutions for teaching/training, exchange of research findings and initiation of new research projects. It encompasses two components:

A short-term stays (“visiting professor”) of around 5-7 days
